How be certified

You can also use this standard to get certified. Once you've established an OHSMS that meets ISO 45001 requirements and addresses your organization's risks and hazards, you can ask a registrar (certification body) to audit your system. If you pass the audit, your registrar will issue an official certificate that states that your organization's OHSMS meets ISO's requirements.
